

Not Your Grandmother's Log Cabin

6-hour Supply List

Class Description: If you want something new, this is it! Take a look at log cabin from a whole new angle as designed by Sara Nephew with Marci Baker. Students will construct log cabin diamonds and triangles using easy step-by-step instructions to create unusual and gorgeous designs. To top it off, the simply amazing designs are amazingly simple, providing success for all levels of quilters. Just cut up your scraps and paint with strips. "Bet you can't make just one!"



In class, you will learn how to make triangles and diamonds. We will be making this log cabin star.

Fabric Selection:

You need chimney (centers) fabric plus light and dark strip fabrics. Fat quarters will work; yardage and even scraps are great. An assortment of fabrics brings more possibilities. Having some 1 1/2" strips pre-cut for class will allow you to make more progress.

Supplies:

- "Not Your Grandmother's Log Cabin" book – If you can not find one, this pattern will be available in class. Purchase of book is required and will be shipped when they are printed in November.
- Rotary cutter, ruler (6" x 12"), and mat
- 60-degree, 10" Clearview™ Triangle, recommended – available at class.
- Sewing machine with basic accessories
- Thread (medium gray or beige)
- Qtools™ Cutting Edge, Sewing Edge, Corner Cut – optional, but highly recommended
- Piece of flannel or batting for design wall. 2' x 3' - optional
